



GoPlay! 2008 Bicycle Safety Poster Contest Rules



Eligibility: The Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD) and the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Safety Divisions have teamed up to offer the 2008 Bicycle Safety Poster Contest. The contest is open to all children ages 6-12.

Contest Period: The contest runs December 3, 2007 at 8:00 a.m. until January 31, 2008 at 5:00 p.m.

Poster Criteria: All entries must be the original artwork of the entrant. Posters that are inappropriate, indecent or obscene, as determined by OPRD and ODOT, will be disqualified. Your submission of a poster is your guarantee that you

are the author and copyright holder of the poster. OPRD and ODOT reserve the right to edit, adapt, and publish any or all of the posters submitted and may use them in any media without attribution or compensation to the contestant. Submission of an entry gives OPRD and ODOT unrestricted rights to use posters without compensation.

Dimensions and Form: All entries must be original flat, two-dimensional drawings, paintings, or renderings. No photographs are permitted. Posters should be at least 8.5"x11" and can be no larger than 11"x17". Submissions will not be accepted in electronic form

and must be mailed or delivered in person. Only hard copy artwork is acceptable. Scanned or other electronic images are NOT eligible and will be disqualified.

How to Enter: Use the entry form in the 2007 Winter Edition of Beaver Tracks (below) and mail it with up to three (3) poster entries. Include your name, age and phone number on the back of all entries. Entries must be mailed or hand delivered to:

2008 Bicycle Safety Poster Contest Rules . . . continued

All entries will become part of OPRD and ODOT's permanent photo collection and will not be returned.

Deadline: The contest officially ends January 31, 2008 at 5 p.m. Entries received by mail must be postmarked by this date. Poster winners will be notified by phone no later than February 29, 2008.

Poster drawings will be included in the 2008 Spring edition of Beaver Tracks.

Judging: Qualified judges will choose contest winners based on the following criteria:

- Originality
- Creativity
- Depiction of at least one safe bicycling practice outlined below:
 - Always wear a helmet
 - Watch for others
 - Be careful where you ride

Prizes:

One (1) Grand Prize:

One (1) Grand Prize poster will be reproduced and used throughout OPRD park sites to inform visitors about bicycle safety practices.

ODOT will award a cool bike helmet to this prize winner.

Seven (7) Honorable Mentions:

Seven (7) honorable mention posters (one for each age group 6-12) will be featured in the 2008 Spring edition of Beaver Tracks. Unique ODOT safety item(s) will be awarded to these seven winners.

The first 250 contestants will receive a prize for entering.

Other uses: Photos submitted to the contest, but not chosen, may be used in future OPRD and/or ODOT print and online communications.
