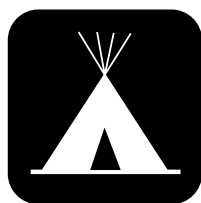
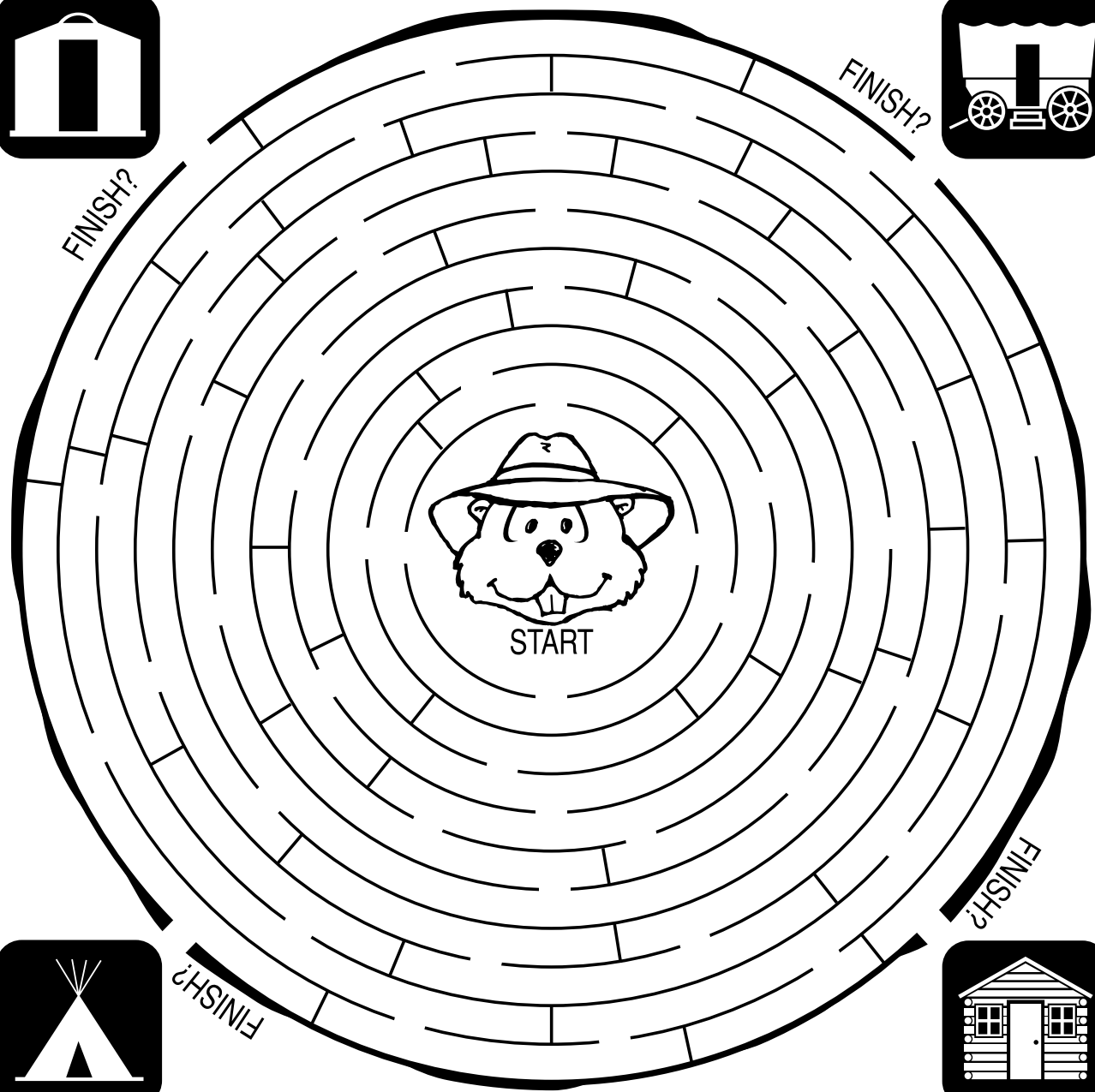


Tree Rings Are Like Birthdays
