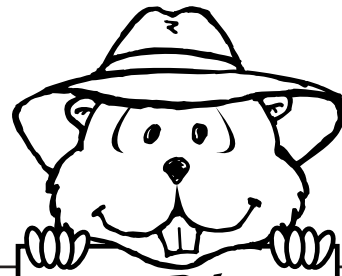


Park Animals
